
Announcement of the AMI (Association Montessori Internationale) Primary Training Course (Montessori 3-6)

We offer you to take part in the full official AMI training course, which will be held for the second time **in St. Petersburg, Russia in 2019-2020** by *The Higher School of The Montessori Method* – the first AMI training center in Russia (www.training.montessori-org.ru).

This course prepares professionals to work with children from 3 to 6 years old. Course graduates will receive AMI "*Casa dei bambini*" *Montessori Diploma*.

The director of the course is AMI trainer **Madlena Ulrich**; co-director is AMI trainer **Gretchen Hall**. Training will be given in English with translation into Russian language; all required materials, albums, and exams can be optionally performed in English or Russian.

The course includes **20 weeks of full-time study** (including the exam week), divided into 4 parts (blocks), with intervals between the parts in a few months, during which students have to complete theoretical and practical tasks required for the successful completion of the course.

Dates of the Blocks:

1. **April 1 – May 3, 2019**
2. **September 16 – October 18, 2019**
3. **February 24 – March 27, 2020**
4. **July 27 – August 28, 2020**

Total Course fee is 9 000 Euro.

Registration fee – 700 Euro (booking the space at the course with enrollment, not refundable).

Course fee is 8 300 Euro, divided into 4 parts. The payment for the block has to be made before each block:

- 1st – 2 300 Euro
- 2nd – 2 300 Euro
- 3rd – 2 300 Euro
- 4th – 2 000 Euro

Special offer in the case of total prepayment (before April 1, 2019) – the **course fee is 7 300 Euro**.

In case of withdrawal from the course this payment will be recalculated according to the standard scheme and refunded for the parts of the course that were not completed.

The Total Course fee covers: registration, administrating of the educational process, lectures and practical training under the guidance of the trainer and course assistants, translation services into Russian/English, library with Montessori's books required for reading (Russian and English), workshops and consultation required for the crafting of the materials, handouts (including necessary materials to create albums), checking albums, final exams procedure, and AMI membership.

The Total Course fee does not cover: transportation, accommodation and meals, costs for books, stationery, expenses for the crafting of the materials, child observation locations, teacher practice between blocks, rechecking albums (if necessary), and re-examinations.

At the start of the training, students must sign an **AMI Student Contract** and **AMI Requirements**. In case of respectful reasons if a student cannot complete this course, she/he has a possibility to complete it later on the next course of The Higher School of The Montessori Method or any AMI 3-6 course in the world (in one year).

The AMI Diploma after the course is the absolute proof of the highest quality Montessori education, recognized throughout the world. Each diploma has a unique number and is entered in the register of the AMI.

Requirements to students: high school diploma, the state of health allowing to work with children, AMI membership for the entire period of the training (can be done at the training center with the start of the course).
